

WELCOME TO THE ELICA RESOURCE CENTER COMMUNITY CLOSET!

Please check in by filling out the Assistance Form and follow the following rules posted below.

- Please do not leave your children unattended.
- Please help us to keep the community closet clean and in organized for the next clients.
- **The capacity of the Community Closet is 7 people.** Please wait outside if the space is already full.
- **The capacity of the lobby is 7 people.** If the room is already full, please wait outside.
- Time in the Community Closet may be limited (20 minutes) if there is a line.
- Please note our opening hours and break times.
We are open from 8:30am to 12:00pm and 1:00pm to 4:00pm.
New visitors may come in **no later than 20 minutes before closing** (end of day or break).
- The limit of visits is **one time a month**.

CLOTHING AND HOUSEHOLD GOODS:

Visitors are welcome to shop for 5 free, quality items of clothing, shoes, household goods and accessories

per person, with a limit of 15 total per family of 3 to allow for all to receive what they need. (Each additional family member can get 5 items.)

Visitors are allowed to receive Winter attire only once a year.

FOOD:

Food is provided once a month. 1 food kit per 1 Elica patient. If there is only 1 Elica patient in your family, only 1 food kit will be provided. Please provide the patient's ID so that our staff member can identify. A food kit is

a selection of items of your choice based on availability and any limits applied to individual items.

INFORMATIONAL RESOURCES:

Resource coordinators are available to assist visitors by connecting those in need to additional services and resources for which they may be eligible by providing contact information of our community partners.

DONATIONS:

We accept clothing and shoes for women, men, and children of all ages and sizes, in excellent condition (please no stains or tears and clothing that is not overly worn), household goods and small kitchen appliances, as well as toys, books, and school supplies.

We have a year round drive for blankets, sleeping bags, tents and tarps to keep our unhoused community warm during the winter months.

If you would like a donation tax receipt - let a staff member know. A receipt will be ready in five business days and emailed to you. You may also request to pick up a hard copy.
